### Organization:

### Position objective

FIND is implementing an innovative project to leverage digital tools coupled with existing diagnostic tools and extend the reach of national surveillance programmes in selected priority low- and middle-income countries (LMICs). The initial focus of this project is on COVID and AMR diagnostics with the potential to extend to other areas of health in the future.

FIND is looking for a consultant candidate to support the Technical Officer leading the implementation of this work. The consultancy is expected to run till December 2022.

### Specific Responsibilities

The specific responsibilities will include but not be limited to:

- Support engagement with technology partners and support the end-to-end product development to ensure the development of fit-for-purpose tools for enabling surveillance. Support the implementation of digital solutions for strengthening surveillance programs in line with country priorities and in close collaboration with country partners
- Supporting comprehensive data collection for monitoring and evaluation of our digital health work as well as supporting dissemination efforts in the form of journal publications and conference presentations
- Collaborating with global health partners and donors in line with FIND's digital health vision
- Any additional task as deemed necessary

## Required Experience

- Bachelor's degree in Computer Science or a related field plus a minimum of 5 years of relevant experience; advanced scientific degree (e.g. MSc or higher) with a focus on software engineering a plus.
- At least 3 years of experience in the design and implementation of digital health solutions in LMICs/resource-constrained settings.
- Experience using popular digital health public goods, cloud computing, data visualization tools.
- A talent for translating complex technological concepts into simple language for a wide-ranging audience, including implementation partners and government partners.
- Experience working with donors, NGOs and/or health ministries is not mandatory but preferable.
- Exceptional stakeholder management skills and a passionate interest in building and sustaining collaborative working relationships.
- Strong communication (written and verbal) skills as well as the ability to work effectively across remotely located teams.
- High level of proficiency in Microsoft Office, particularly Excel, PowerPoint and Word
- Professional level English essential
- Willingness to travel frequently in line with applicable health and safety considerations
